Our clinical services are grounded in evidence based clinical methods and students will learn and be exposed to a wide variety of these practices to include:

- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT)
- Trauma Focused CBT
- CBT for Suicide Prevention
- Dialectic Behavioral Therapy (DBT)
- Collaborative Assessment and Management of Suicidality (CAMS)
- Multi-Dimensional Family Therapy
- Parent Child Interactive Therapy
- Eye Movement Desensitization Reprocessing (EMDR)

Clinical Supervision

Students on a clinical track should expect **at least one hour per week of one-on-one supervision** with their supervisor. Students can also expect to be a part of routine treatment team meetings led by a psychiatrist.

Training Opportunities

Our interns will have access to a wide variety of training and professional development experiences that are offered to staff on an ongoing basis. These include in-person classroom/workshop style trainings, virtual clinical reviews and consultations, and access to conferences and seminars such as the annual Lowcountry Mental Health Conference held in Charleston every summer.
